Hazards

Some walking on lanes and narrow roads without pavements. Exposed cliff edges on the Coast Path with steep drops. Keep out of the MOD danger area. May be livestock in fields near Hill Farm. Coast paths and cliff edges may be slippery after rain.

Accessibility

There are stiles on the route and gates and paths less than one metre wide. There are no steps. Some rough ground with ruts or stones exceeding 10cm. Occasional loud bangs from MOD Manorbier.

Navigation

Following roads and well marked paths and tracks. Careful navigation required to divert around the blocked right of way after Hill Farm.

Terrain

Includes paved roads, grass and some rough ground.



Facilities (see map)

Pub off route in Manorbier village.



No seats on route



Not wheelchair accessible

Not stile free

Before you go:

- Check the local weather forecast and whether there is enough daylight to complete the walk (metoffice.gov.uk) and check tide times near you (easytide.admiralty.co.uk).
- Ensure you are wearing suitable clothing and footwear for the route and weather, and that you take the right kit – learn more at yha.org.uk/walk-skills.
- Download the OS Maps and what3words apps to your phone.

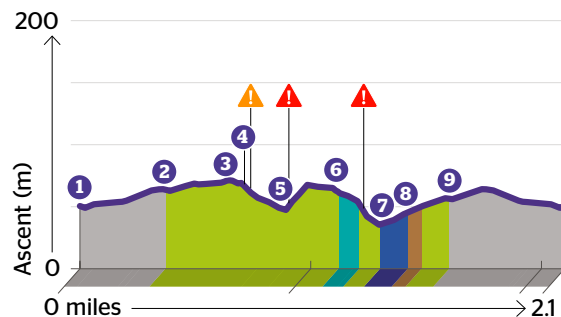

- 1 From the hostel turn right.
- 2 At Manorbier Camp entrance turn right. Then turn left along the perimeter fence and follow the Wales Coast Path.
- 3 At the fence corner turn left and follow the fence towards the coast.
- 4 Go through the gate and follow the Coast Path.
- 5 Turn right just before the gate next to the stone wall. Or to visit Presipe Beach pass through the gate and take the steps on the left.
- 6 Follow the footpath through Hill Farm.
- 7 Turn right onto the track.
- 8 The right of way to Manorbier Camp is blocked, continue ahead and follow the path through a meadow. Then head around to the right, to reach the road.
- 9 At the road turn right towards Manorbier camp, then retrace the route to the hostel.
