

Route Summary

A lovely stroll around the harbour and docks with history and regeneration side by side. From the hostel turn left and follow the path around to Prince Street, cross the bridge, turn right onto Princes Wharf. Follow the waterside, turn left before Great Western Dockyard onto Gas Ferry Road and take the cut through on the right to Hanover Place. Turn right to Bristol Marina, turn left along the waterside and turn left at The Cottage Inn to Cumberland Road. Turn right, right onto Avon Crescent, bear right and just before the bridge join the waterside path on the left. Take care next to the water as there are no barriers in places. Bear right onto the walkway to the island and pass under the Plimsoll Swing Bridge. Cross the river using the lock gates, turn right along the water's edge and back under the bridge. Follow the waterside path, take care on walkways with no barriers. Pass Pooles Wharf, Hanover Quay and the amphitheatre and head along The Waterfront to the end of the harbour. Turn right, then right onto Narrow Quay and follow the waterside path back to the hostel.

Accessibility

The route follows roads with pavements and pedestrianised streets. Flat surfaces throughout – mostly tarmac, paved or small block paving. To cross the river at Plimsoll Bridge involves narrow paths close to the water's edge and a step onto and off the lock. To avoid this cross at Merchants. Road (at the end of Avon Crescent) and turn right past the Pump House to re-join the waterside path. Just after Gasworks Lane there is a flight of steps down to a small marina. To avoid this turn left onto Gasworks Lane, right onto Lime Kiln Road, right onto Anchor Road, right onto Canons Way, right onto Cathedral Walk and then left to re-join the waterside path.
